

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
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ARIKAN ROOTS IN THE PAST, PIONEERING THE FUTURE

A dive into the origins bears witness to their remarkable evolution and embraces their vision for a sustainable, respectful and innovative future.






ARIKAN TEXTILES

Originally established in 1954 as an agricultural enterprise in Kahramanmaraş, ARIKAN started its business journey with 500 hectares of cotton fields. It quickly evolved into a vertically integrated textile structure, encompassing spinning, weaving and dyeing processes. The company quickly established itself as a major player in the Turkish industry. With a production capacity of around 1.500 tons per month, including 80 tons of spinning, 60 tons of knitting and 60 tons of dyeing, ARIKAN has won recognition for its excellence. It currently employs 1.500 people and operates 220 knitting machines, ensuring the highest quality and efficiency in its operations.



The company prioritizes trust and integrity, this is why it chose FibreTrace®, a digital technological tool developed to improve transparency and traceability within the global textile supply chain. Its regenerative agriculture program, called Good Earth Cotton®, reduces the environmental impact of cotton while preserving soil health and biodiversity. To achieve circularity goals, ARIKAN is also working on regenerative agriculture, exploiting its own fields and drawing on their family heritage.







PRODUCTION CAPACITY AND MARKET PRESENCE

ARIKAN's production capacity has increased significantly, currently reaching 5.000.000 meter per month or 1.500 tons per month. This capability enables ARIKAN to meet the demands of its valued customers, which include global brands and apparel manufacturers. It prides itself on providing high quality products while staying true to its vision of innovation, circularity and sustainability, such as the vapour process that is a smart move to use water in dye house to save resources and energy.





FUTURE GOALS AND VISION

Looking ahead, ARIKAN's vision remains clear and precise. It aims to move forward on its path of innovation, exploring new horizons in circularity and sustainability.

By cultivating strategic partnerships and pioneering innovative projects, ARIKAN aims to be at the forefront of industry advances, setting new benchmarks for the sector and continuing to make a difference in the world of textiles.

Its goal is not only to create outstanding products, but also to leave a positive and lasting impact on the textile industry and the environment. With this goal, ARIKAN is working on a solar plant project, with a size of 30 MW for the solar plant and 9 MW for the cogeneration plant, in order to generate a significant amount of energy.
